

ROAD CAPTAIN GUIDELINES

If you'd like to become a road captain there are a few guidelines to be followed to maintain this position.

Attend 6 regular chapter meetings within a year, Jan-Dec.

Attend 6 Road Captains meeting within a year, Jan.-Dec.

Help with parties at Stock's Harley-Davidson, a minimum of 4 hours per total, within a year, Jan.-Dec.

Participate in a chapter ride, or dealer ride, Jan.-Dec.

You must be a road captain for a full year for the chapter to pay a portion of a first aid kit for your bike, or a safety course (Accident Scene Management Course) that you might participate in.

There are always acceptations to the rules. Such as if you work second shift and cannot attend the road captains meeting, but participate in the other areas required you will be able to be a road captain.
